Guidelines

Inside Outside Communications Foundation, announces the 2023 *Inside Outside Communications Foundation Scholarship Program.* Under the Program, we will award two scholarships, to seniors. Contact the Foundation directly for more information.

Available Scholarships:

Baker Newton Scholarship: One (1) \$300 to \$1,000 scholarship available for High school seniors.

Fikes Honeycutt Scholarship: One (1) \$300 to \$1,000 scholarship available for High School seniors.

Program Guidelines & Priorities:

* Seeking graduating seniors with a record of volunteering in the community for non-school sponsored activities and participation in extracurricular school activities.

* Applicants must have a minimum GPA of 2.0 and plan to attend a 2 or 4 year college or technical school.

* Scholarship funds will be paid *in July 2023 directly to the student*. It will be the student's responsibility to submit to the Foundation student ID number, proof of acceptance and class schedule.

* Applicants must submit recommendation from their School Counselor with their application attesting they are a qualified candidate for this scholarship. Application deadline is <u>May 29, 2023</u> by 4:00 p.m. to be received by the Foundation Committee. Late applications are not accepted.
